



**PLAZA REHABILITATION & LANE
CLOSURES INCLUDING EXTRA-WIDE
LANES AT SWARTRUGGENS TOLL PLAZA**

Bakwena will start with the concrete slab rehabilitation at the Swartruggens Toll Plaza.

From the 29th April 2013 the extra-wide lane westbound and one lane eastbound will be closed.

Upon completion of the initial two lanes closed for rehabilitation, the Contractor will proceed with closing the extra-wide eastbound lane as well as the remaining westbound lane.

There will be special traffic accommodation in place. Bakwena will cater for contra-flow for extra-wide vehicles through the plaza whilst an extra-wide lane is closed. The construction period is anticipated to be approximately five and a half months.

The contractor will be working to an accelerated program to ensure these works are carried out timeously and with as little disruption to the traffic as possible. Please note that from time to time, normally on a Friday, there may be protests at the plaza. This may have a negative impact on traffic flow.

Infrastructure needs constant attention to ensure that it remains in an acceptable condition. The rehabilitation works at the Swartruggens Plaza as well as the rehabilitation works between Swartruggens and Rustenburg, which have progressed well are testimonies to Bakwena's commitment.
